BIOGRAPHICAL DETAILS HIS EXCELLENCY HOR NAM BORA

Hor Nam Bora was born on 27 July 1957- Married to Ouch Khemtana (3 children)

He holds a Pre-Bachelor of Mathematics and Physics, University of Paris, France – and a Doctor degree from the Institute of International Relations and Political Studies, University of Economics of Budapest, Hungary

After working at the Genocide Museum in Toul Sleng, as researcher (1980-85), and Director of the Humanitarian Relief Committee in Kompong Som Port (1986-87), He joined the Foreign Ministry in 1988, a year later when Cambodia shifted towards free market economics. He was rewarded with postings to Thailand (1993-96) and a scholarship to the United Nations in Geneva (1994-95) before becoming **Deputy Permanent Representative to the UN Economic and Social Committee for Asia and the Pacific in Thailand (1995-96)**.

On return to Cambodia, He was appointed **Under Secretary of State and Foreign Affairs Adviser of the Head of State**, positions he held from 1996 until 1998.

Mr. Hor Nam Bora was posted **as Ambassador to Australia and New Zealand in 1999**, albeit as a political appointee. He thrived there, picking up **the Australian Committee on Human Rights Education's 'Citizen of Humanity' award in 2002**.

He left Canberra in October 2004 and was until now, **Cambodian Ambassador to UK, Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Norway and Sweden**; currently he holds the position as **“Dean of the Asian Countries’ Group** in London.

Ambassador Hor Nam Bora was admitted as **"Distinguished Fellow"** given under the authority of the Association of Certified Commercial Diplomats in London, England and, **"Status of Chartered Diplomat"** by Association of Certified Commercial Diplomats Headquarters London (2007).

He was decorated as **“Commander” of the Royal Order of Cambodia** (2007) and **“Grand Officer” of the Royal Order of Cambodia** (2010).

Mr. Hor Nam Bora was promoted as **Advisor with rank of Minister to the Royal Government of Cambodia (2009)** and, **appointed as Special Envoy of the Prime Minister of Cambodia (2011) in charge of the Campaign Promoting Cambodia’s Candidature to the United Nations Security Council 2013-2104**.

Recently, the Royal Government of Cambodia appointed HE. Hor Nam Bora, **Ambassador Designate of Cambodia to Ethiopia, as Permanent Representative of Cambodia to the African Union (2011)**, with residence in London.
